

# Kickapoo Valley Reserve

## COVID-19 Policies in effect until further notice

- \* All campsites are **CLOSED** for camping. Day parking allowed .
- \* KVR Trails are **OPEN** to hiking, horse and bike.
- \* *Hikers:* Trails remain **OPEN** during wet conditions.
- \* *Horseback riders:* Trails **CLOSE** during wet conditions. Hay Valley Trail from Dutch Hollow Trail to Intersection 10/Bailout Trail is **CLOSED** due to flood damaged bridge.
- \* *Bicyclists:* Trails **CLOSE** during wet conditions. Yield to horses.
- \* Purchase Parking Permit, Day Pass and/or Annual Permit online: <http://kickapoovalley.wi.gov/Home>
- \* Hunting and fishing allowed in compliance with DNR seasons and licensing.
- \* Old Hwy 131 Trail **CLOSED** to Horse & Bike when natural surface trails closed due to wet conditions.
- \* Visitor Center is **CLOSED** to the public.
- \* Outdoor restrooms at the KVR Visitor Center are **OPEN**.
- \* Stay 6 feet apart.
- \* If there are several cars in one place, have a plan B.
- \* Man-made surfaces (tables/gates) not disinfected.
- \* Keep vehicles on solid surfaces in designated areas.
- \* ALL dogs on leash at ALL times.
- \* Do not leave human/pet waste above ground. Dig cat holes and cover waste at least 200 ft from campsites, water sources and trails. Bag and remove pet waste or bury.
- \* Take ALL trash and belongings with you.
- \* Burning ban - no fires of any kind.
- \* Do not dispose of trash or food items in the firepit.
- \* Call 911 for all Emergencies.
- \* Check KVR Website or Facebook Page for updates.
- \* Policies subject to change if violations or Federal/State directives require!
