## MEET THE AUTHOR



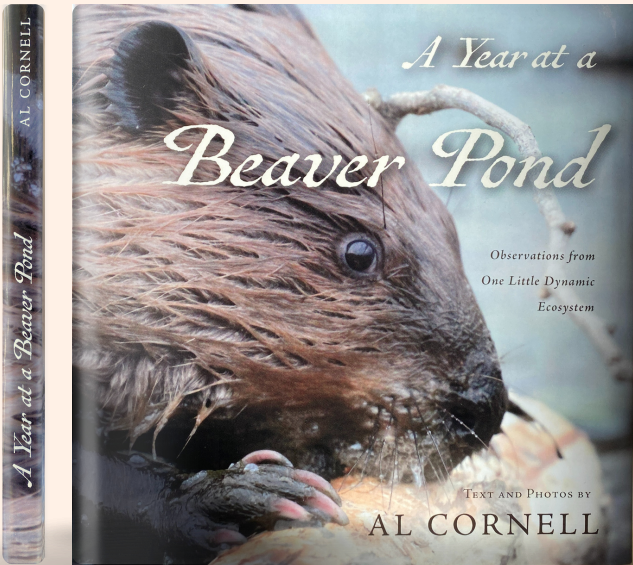
